- 11b This structure is a rectangular wood frame barn with a gambrel style sheet metal roof. The lower part has uncoarsed faced rock walls. The ends of the upper part have vertical wood plank walls.
- 11c The garage is a rectangular wood frame structure with a front gable asbestos shingle roof and uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11d This small square wood frame structure is noted as a summer kitchen. It has a front gable asbestos shingle roof, a rock foundation, and uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11e This structure is a small square wood frame shed with a front gable asbestos shingle roof, rock foundation and uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11f This structure is a rectangular wood frame chicken coop with a shed style sheet metal roof. Part of the front of this structure is covered in a vertical wood plank wall. The remainder of the structure has uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11g
&h These structures are small rectangular wood frame chicken coops with side gable sheet metal roofs. The upper part of the structures are covered with vertical wood planks. The remainder of the structures is covered in uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11i This is a three sided lean-to structure used for the storage of hay. It has a sheet metal shed style roof that is supported by poured concrete pillars. The walls are made of uncoarsed natural rock.
- 11j This shed is a small square wood frame structure with a sheet metal shed style roof and uncoarsed natural rock walls.
- 11k This structure is a rectangular wood frame shed with a side gable sheet metal roof. The upper half of the building walls are covered in vertical wood plank and the lower walls are made of uncoarsed natural rock.
