

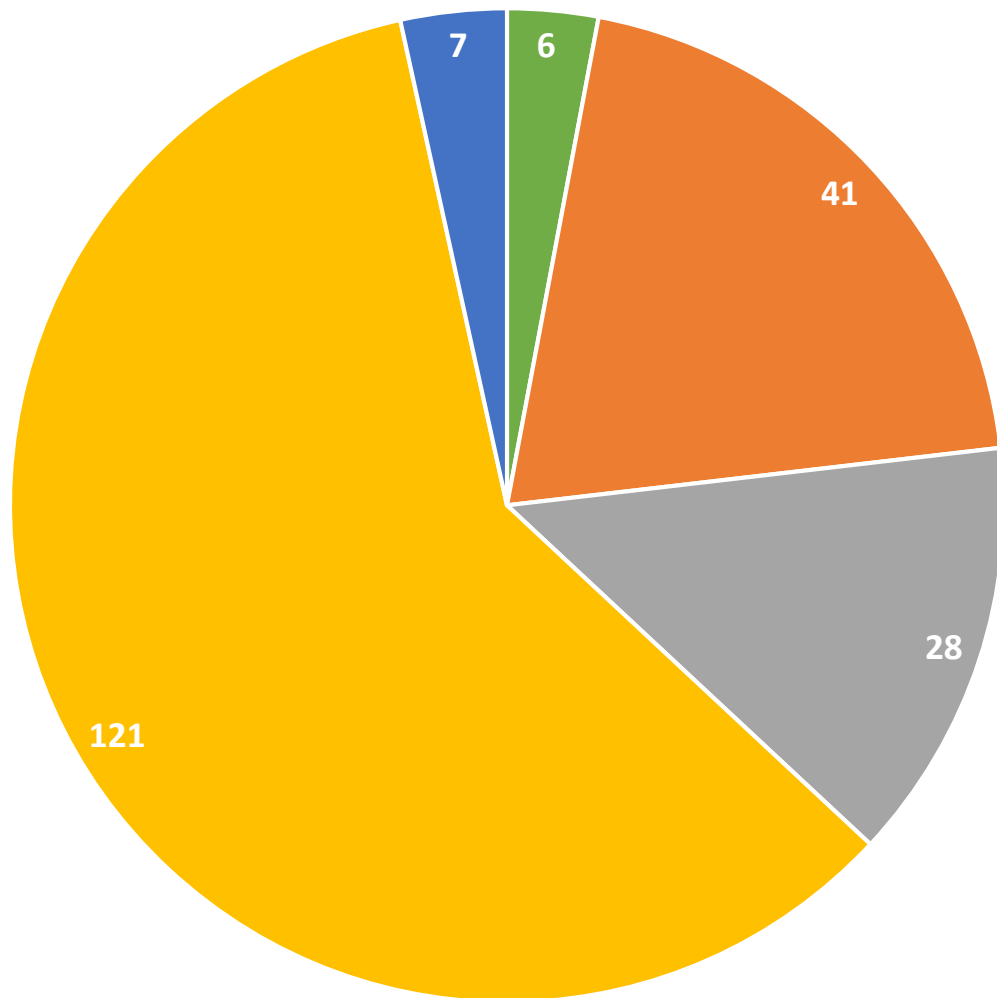

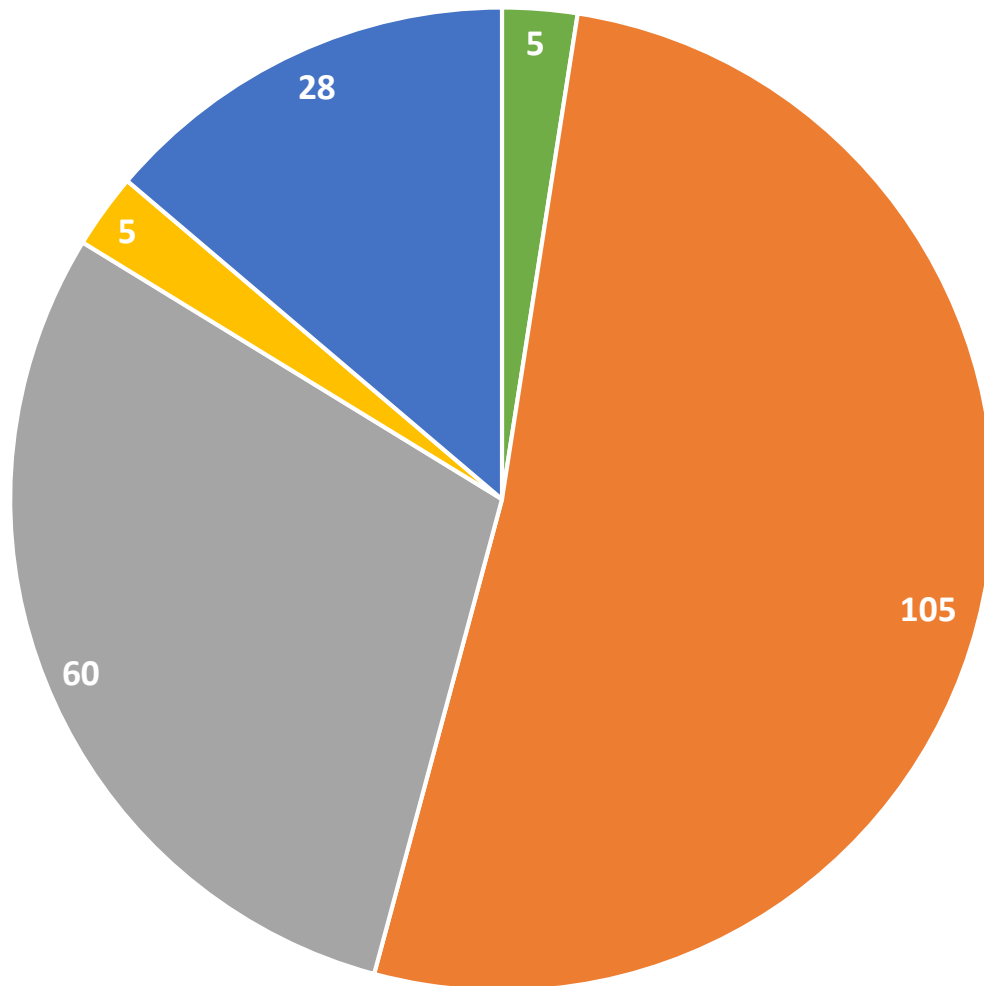
HOW OFTEN DO YOU VISIT THIS STATE

QUESTION #2

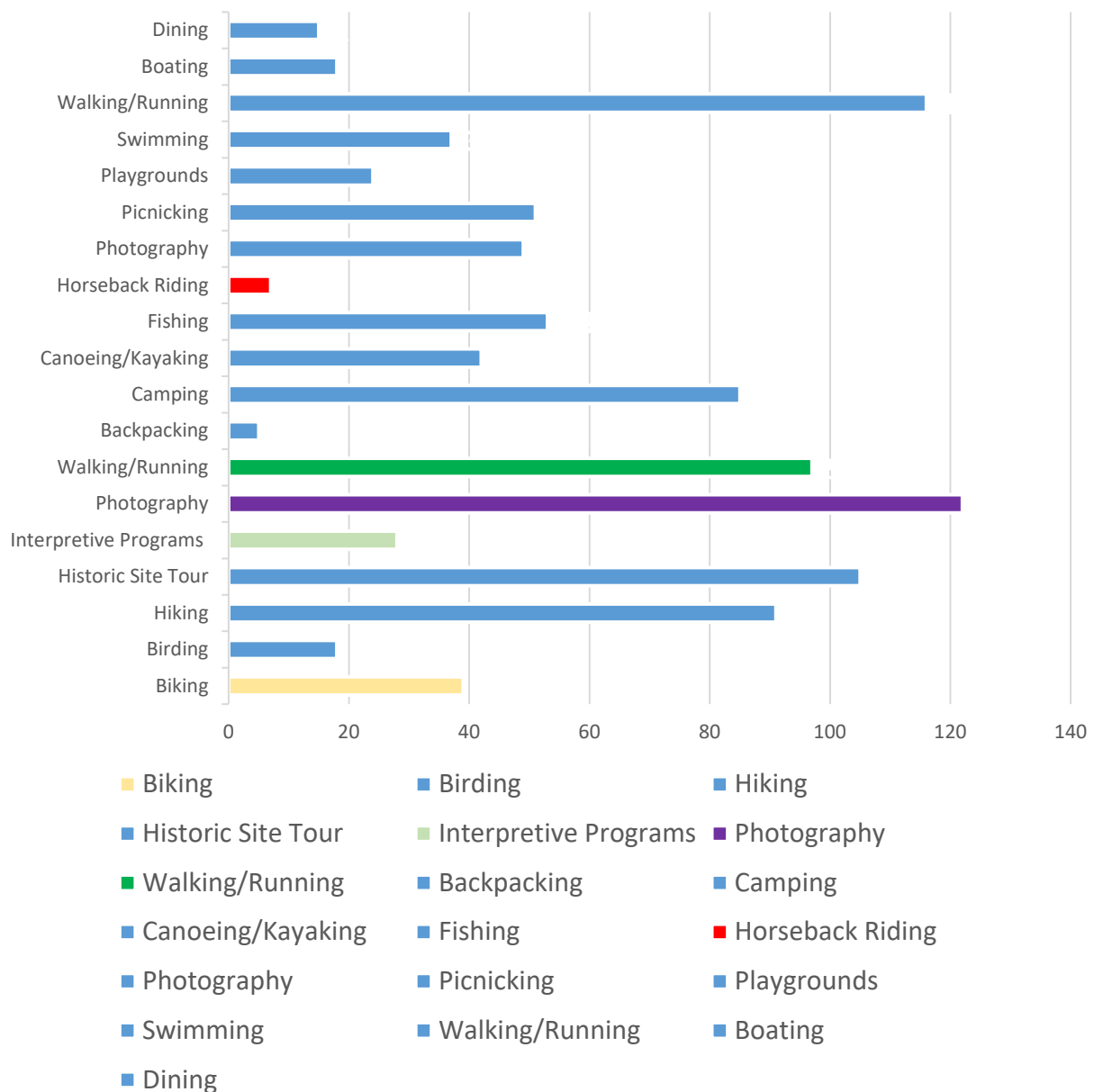
WHEN YOU VISIT THIS STATE PARK, WHO USUALLY JOINS YOU?

WHICH RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES ARE YOU ENGAGING IN DURING YOUR VISIT(S)?

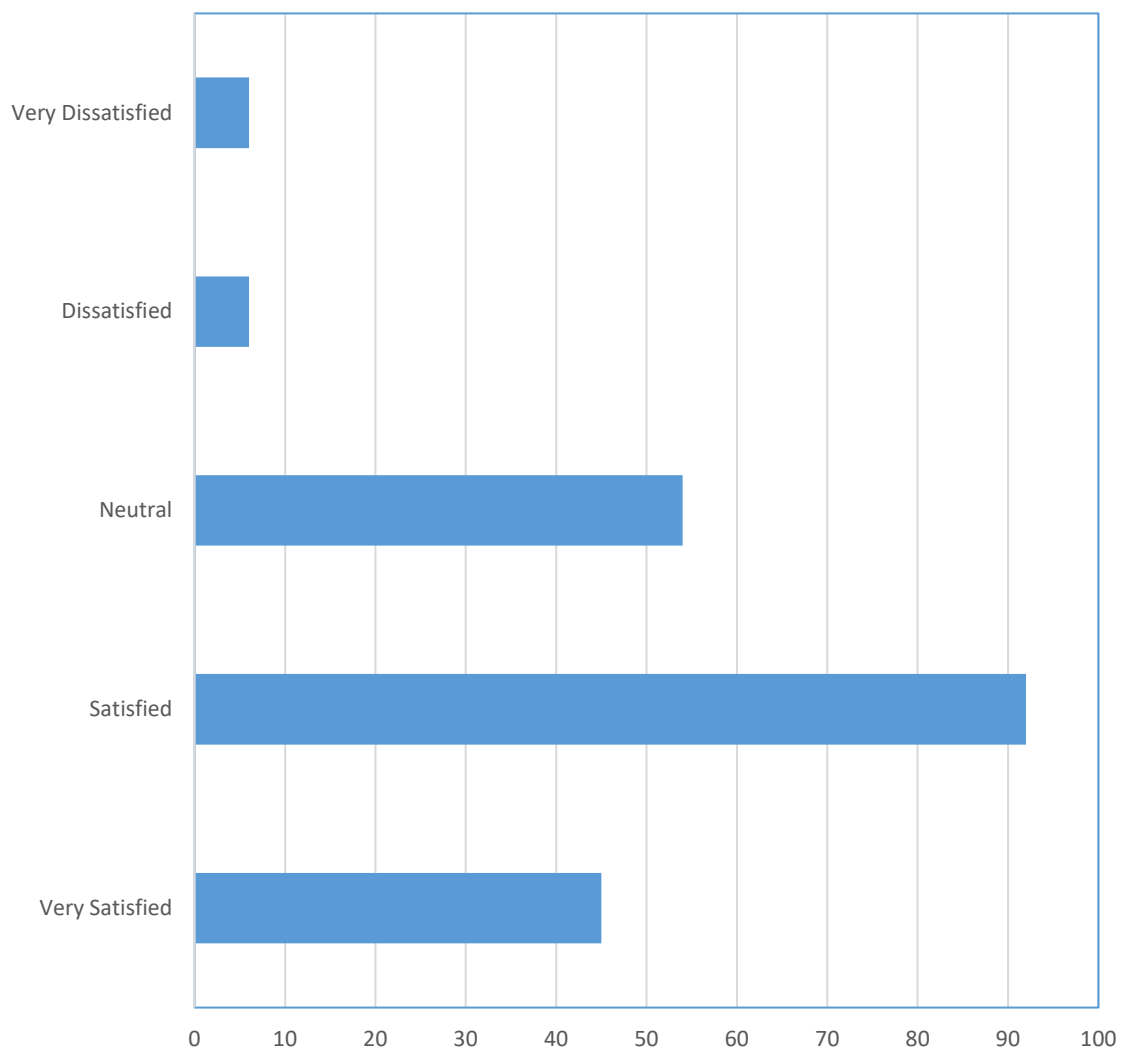

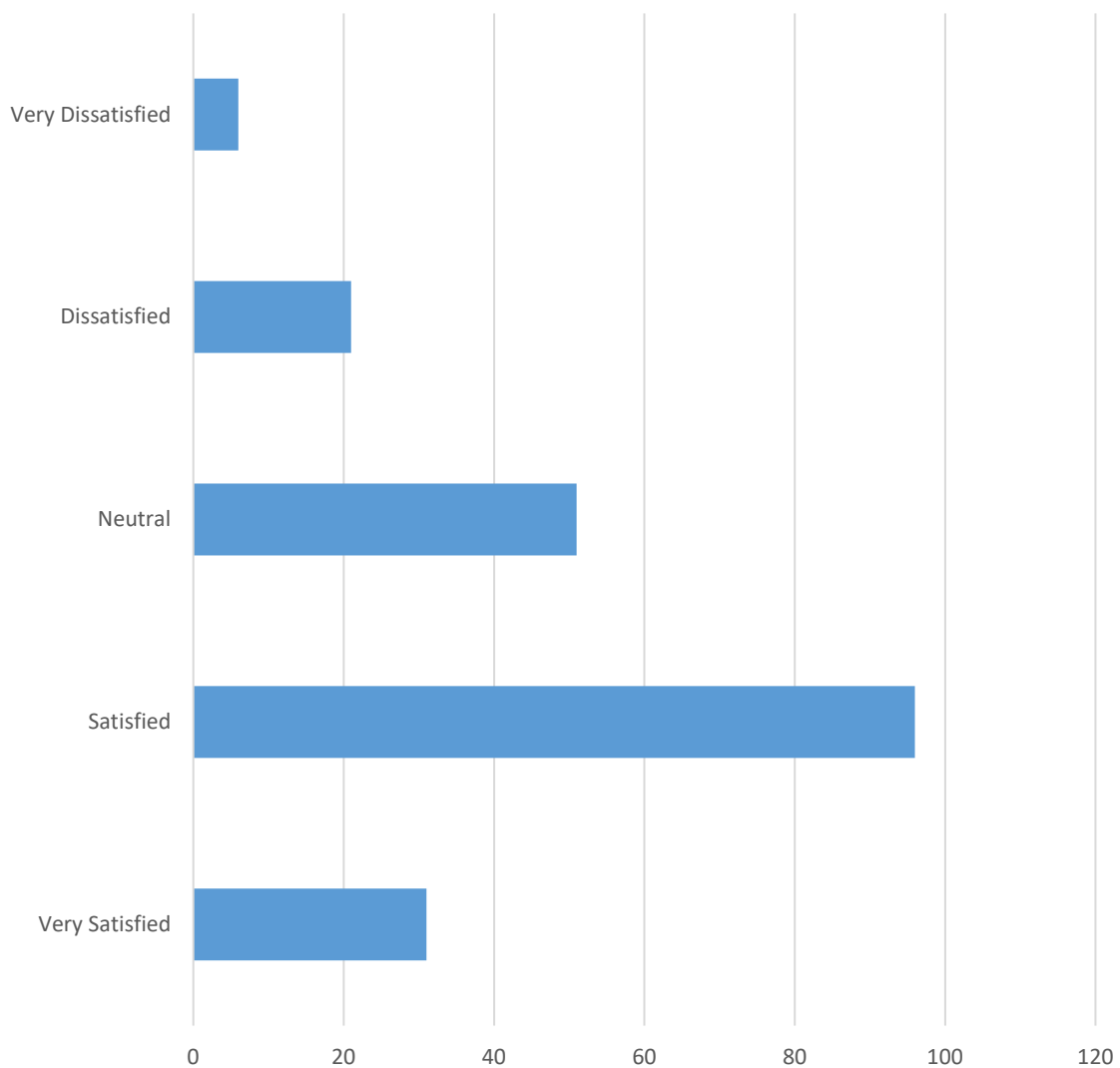
QUESTION #4
